Jute is a natural fibre and second to cotton in global production. It is 100% biodegradable and is a fully sustainable resource. The crop is mainly rain-fed with little need for fertilisers or pesticides - so it is an ecologically-friendly alternative to plastic or cotton.

What is it used for?

Jute was traditionally used as gunny sacks for potatoes, tea, coffee and grain. Recent efforts to reduce plastic bag usage, coupled with its strong, long-lasting qualities has meant demand for jute has increased in various forms - including shopping bags, wine bottle bags, sandwich bags, garden tip bags and fashion bags.

Following extensive research into key characteristics associated with reusable bags, from the table below you can see that jute performs the best in every category - making it the most ecologically-friendly option in reusable bags.
